NewPage printing paper samples have been tested for lead using test method EPA 6010 which incorporates an Inductively Coupled Plasma (ICP) source.

The detection limit for test method EPA 6010 is 2.0 kg/mg or 2 ppm or 0.0002%.

The results of these tests were Non-Detectable (ND) for lead i.e. lead was not detected in the printing paper samples.
